Protective Behaviours Training



A Personal Safety Program



The Language of Safety

A key principle of Protective Behaviours, a personal safety program, recognising the importance of establishing a common language which creates an environment promoting open discussion of issues of safety. Includes Quality of Language, Shared Meaning, Ownership, and Clarity.

Unwritten Rules of Society

Explores the societal rules which shape our attitudes and behaviours, and the possible impact of these rules on our personal safety.

Thoughts, Feelings and Behaviours

Outlines the relationship between thoughts, feelings, and behaviours, focussing on the premise that: Feelings are feelings, behaviour is a choice with an effect, and we can use our thinking to influence both. If we are to adopt help-seeking behaviours in times when we feel unsafe, we need to change how we think and feel about safety.

Theme 1: “We all have the right to feel safe all of the time”

The first theme of Protective Behaviours emphasises safety as the rights of everyone, the importance of shared Rights and Responsibilities, the Continuum of Safety, and Body Signals which tell us when we feel unsafe.

Theme 2: “Nothing is so awful that we can’t talk about it with someone”

Explores strategies for talking to people about our problems, the possible effects of talking, and how to establish an effective personal network.

This one day workshop is a practical empowerment and resilience program which provides a comprehensive approach to all aspects of physical and psychological safety.

The program has wide ranging applications for those working with children, young people, vulnerable families and clients.

In this workshop participants will have the opportunity to explore, through discussion and practical activities, their own ideas and beliefs about safety and the joys and challenges of working with children and young people around concepts such as keeping themselves safe, problem solving, making decisions and abuse prevention.
